What is Euphemism?

We are a Creative Arts Journal that publishes two editions yearly containing poetry, fiction, nonfiction, visual art, experimental sound, spoken word, videos, and original music. We accept submissions from artists all over the world, including our very own ISU students.

What do Euphemism members do?

As a member of Euphemism, you will join at least one of four committees to assist in the publication process. You can join the Fiction, Nonfiction, Art/Media, and/or Poetry committees. The work of the committees won't start until *after* our submissions deadline. You will then read/watch/listen to all the pieces from your committee and collectively decide which pieces will be published.

Is this a big time commitment?

This question depends on how much time you put in. We have *mandatory* staff meetings as well as *optional* staff meetings. Our mandatory meetings will focus on the logistics and progression of the issue we will publish that semester. We hold optional staff meetings primarily to connect with your fellow members and foster a sense of community during this unpredictable time. You also have the option to join multiple committees, but you must be prepared to go through all the submissions for every committee you are a part of.

Can I submit to Euphemism if I am a member?

Of course! We encourage our members to submit any creative works they are proud of, but it is not mandatory for members to submit. When we review our submissions, they go through a blind review so Euphemism members do not know who's submission they are reading.
